

MIS Summer School 2012 Courses Policy: On-line only

High School Students please be advised that the only summer school courses that will be offered at MIS during summer of 2012 are on-line courses. Student failing either segment (**semester I or II**) of their core subjects (exception: Arabic/Philippine Language) must take the course on-line with the Florida Virtual School. This way, there is an assurance that the failing student repeats the **full substance** of the failed course(s).

Students **will not** be able to advance in a course by passing one (1) segment of the course. In other words, to graduate from MIS all students, and seniors in particular, **must pass both segments of their courses this school year. This notice will be placed on MIS' Web-site.**

Additionally, students will be required to finish the online course by September 1st or prior to the first day of classes for the ensuing year. Failure to finish the course successfully will effect the student's ability to enroll in the successor course (example: geometry Segment/semester I and II-to-Algebra II. This could result in the student having to take the next successor course online also, at the expense of his/her parents.
